

## Configure Open VPN Mobile Servers - Android Devices

---

1. Save your mobile VPN key files that you have received from [helpdesk@gtt.tools](mailto:helpdesk@gtt.tools) onto your Android device.
2. From your Play Store, install the “OpenVPN Connect” app by OpenVPN. It has an icon that looks like this:

3. Once it is installed on your Android device, open up OpenVPN Connect app.
4. Click on “AGREE” on the next window that will pop up (in the red circle on the picture):



5. Click on “FILE” on the next window that will pop up (in the red circle on the picture):



6. Click on “Allow” on the next window (in the red circle on the picture):



7. Find your Download folder (in the red circle on the picture) and click on it to open it up:



8. Once you do that you will get access to all your keys that saved before. Highlight the first one in the list in order to import in and then click on "IMPORT" (in the red circle on the picture):



9. Click on “ADD” (in the red circle on the picture) to finish importing your key to your app:




10. Click on “+” (in the red circle on the picture) to add the rest of your keys one by one:



11. Once you import all of the keys, you can then choose any of them to connect. Slide “Connection” bar to the right in order to connect (in the red circle on the picture):




Before you get connected you will get a following window:



Click "OK".

12. Now you are connected. There are a few ways to confirm that the VPN is connected and working. The first way will be two small icons (in the red circle on the picture) that appear in the left top corner of your screen. The second way is in the "OpenVPN Connect" app itself:

**VPN Connection Tip:** In general, you should use the server that is geographically closest to you as that will provide you the best internet speeds. If you are in Asia or South America, use the east coast US servers. For Europe and Africa users, connect to the Europe or west coast US servers. However, you are welcome to connect to whichever one provides you with the best and fastest connection for you.
