


Configure Open VPN Mobile Servers- iDevices

Before you start setting up the VPN on your iDevice (iPhone, iPad, iPod), make sure that you have received your mobile VPN keys from helpdesk@gtt.tools

1. From your App Store, install OpenVPN Connect app by OpenVPN Technologies. It has an icon which looks like this:




2. Find your email message with the keys:






4. Right click on the first key and from the window that pops up choose "Copy to Open VPN":





5. The chosen key will automatically show up in your OpenVPN app. Click on "+" sign in (a red circle on the picture) to add it:




6. Once it is added you will see it in the list:


7. You can add all of them or few of them:




In general, you should use the servers that is geographically closest to you as that will provide you the best internet speeds. If you are in Asia or South America, use the west coast US servers. For Europe and Africa users, connect to the Europe or east coast US servers. However, you are welcome to connect to whichever one provides you with the best and fastest connection for you.

8. Slide "Connection" bar in order to connect:






9. Choose "Yes":



10. Once you successfully connect you will get "VPN" sign on the top left corner of your iDevice:
